Philam Life Runs for Healthy Education

The Philippine education system has been plagued with shortfalls in both human resources and infrastructure. Statistics from the Department of Education (DepEd) show that the Philippines has a classroom shortage of about 152,000, assuming a student-teacher ratio of 1:45. With additional classrooms, more pupils can be accommodated by our public school system.

With this in mind, Philam Life recently held a running event called “Run for Healthy Education: The Philam Paaralan Family Fun Run.” The run is for the benefit of Philam Foundation’s “Philam Paaralan” program which builds entire school buildings (including classrooms and restrooms) and provides additional facilities (such as chairs, blackboards, etc.) for public schools located in unserved and underserved areas in provinces around the Philippines. The event successfully collected P327,500 in registration fees and donations from 939 runners, sponsors and donors which will fund the construction of a Philam Paaralan classroom.

Philam Paaralan was formed in March 2011 in partnership with DepEd to assist in the shortage of school infrastructure. Last June 30, a total of eight (8) classrooms fully furnished with restrooms were turned over to the province of Isabela. Four pilot schools under the Philam Paaralan Program benefited Alibagu

Elementary School and Manaring Integrated School in Ilagan; and Regional Science High School and Ugad Elementary School in Tumauni.

“We need to make basic education accessible to as many learners as we can reach, which we can consider as a solid investment for the future,” stated DepEd Chief Bro. Armin Luistro. “We are all stakeholders of education. Education is not the sole responsibility of DepEd. At the end of the day, we are all accountable for the education of our people.”

Philam Foundation aims to bring education to underprivileged areas by partnering with various organizations. In addition to providing education infrastructure, Philam Paaralan will also be providing a health component in the program in the form of water sanitation and hygiene (WASH) in keeping with the Healthy Living CSR thrust of its corporate parent, the AIA Group.

AIA recently contracted a Healthy Living Index study across the 15 markets it operates in Asia-Pacific (including the Philippines), conducting over 10,200 interviews across the region. The study shows that majority of Filipinos (74%) see ‘regular exercise’ as one of the important drivers of healthy living, but is an item they do not give themselves high ratings as only 37% say they are satisfied with the amount of regular exercise they get. Moreover 42% of Filipinos revealed that they exercise only one hour or less in a week. That is why Philam Life promotes healthy living through this fun run, while supporting healthy education through Philam Paaralan.
