- D. Philam Foundation has been awarded a second grant amounting to 86,960 USD (PhP4,352,348.00) by the Japan Embassy’s program, Japan-Bangsamoro Initiatives for Reconstruction and Development (J-BIRD) through the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP). The Grant Contract Signing was done with Embassy of Japan’s Ambassador, Kazuhide Ishikawa last March 10, 2017 at Embassy of Japan, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City. The a previous grant amounting to 102,333 USD(PhP 4,794,608.05) was awarded last March 2016 to build 5 classrooms at Bayugan National Comprehensive High School, which was successfully turned over last February 2017.
