- c. The 6-classroom building in partnership with Embassy of Japan will be turned over on June 2019.
- d. PFI has turned over 5-classrooms in Butig National High School last March 21, 2019. These classrooms were in partnership with AY Foundation and the Family of Amb. Alfonso Yuchengco in honor of him.

- a. The 8 classrooms in 4 schools in Marawi City are on going construction. Target to turn over on June 2019 in time for opening of classes. VP Leni Robredo will be invited to the said event since they partnered with us for the Site Selection.
- b. Mr. Diosdado Banatao, a microchip inventor has partnered with us to build in his alma mater, Malabbac Elementary School, in their hometown at Iguig, Cagayan. This partnership is for a total of 6 classrooms. The Memorandum of Agreement Signing and Cermeonial Groundbreaking was held last February 20, 2019.
- c. LBC Foundation has partnered with us to build in another 5 island provinces which are Romblon, Batanes, Camiguin, Siquijor, Guimaras and another school in Benguet Provinces for a total of 12 classrooms. Target Memorandum of Agreement Signing is on April 2019.
- d. The Memorandum of Agreement Signing with Kasilak-Dole Stanfilco to build 1-storey 3-classroom building in Makilala, North Cotabato was held last February 20, 2019.
- e. At the end of 2018, we have built a total of 171 classrooms since 2011 and we are present at 40 provinces out of 81 provinces of the country.
- f. When we include our pending projects, we built 206 classrooms all over the country.
- g. This 2019, we target to build 45 classrooms in additional 20 provinces of the country.

II. Philam SAVES

- A. For year 2018, 43 sessions were held for both Philam SAVES Jr. and Sr. Total of 13,454 students, parents and teachers benefited from the sessions. Volunteer's engagement totaled to 631 with 1,801 volunteer hours committed.
- B. Year to date (January 2017-March 2019), 59 sessions were held for both Philam SAVES Jr. and Sr. Total of 18,513 students, parents and teachers benefited from the sessions. Volunteer's engagement totaled to 882 with 2,743 volunteer hours committed.

- C. Three (3) BPI Caravans were scheduled in Maharlika ES, CP. Tinga ES and Capt. Cardones from February-March 2019. There were 310 students who were able to open their accounts under BPI's Jumpstart Program.
- D. PHSaves: KaAkbayanihan Towards Financial Awareness
The nationwide Philam SAVES initiative was held last October 12, 2018 in 9 sites across the country. For 2019, two (2) nationwide Philam SAVES will be conducted during the Savings Awareness Month on July 1-5 and PLIA Month on October 7-11, 2019.
- E. Philam SAVES won under the Social Empowerment Category at the Asia Responsible Enterprise Awards (AREA) 2018.
- F. Based on the consultation with PFI Chairman, Philam SAVES will slowly be moving to concentrate its resources to focus teaching teachers, parents and adults.

III. PhilamCAN

- a. At the end of 2018, a total of P555,000 was assisted to 54 Philam Group employees.
- b. Remaining Fund at the end of 2018 is P1,304,160.00
- c. PCAN Online Caravan will be relaunched on April 2019.

IV. Solidarity and Welfare Fund

- a. As of December 2018, 81 Financial Advisors were given assistance amounting to P765,000.00.
- b. AS of March 2019, 12 Financial Advisors have been given assistance amounting to P190,000.00
- c. First tranche of pledge collected from the Advisor's SOA amounting to P778,100.
